WHEREAS we previously resolved to “Begin Phase I of the Master Plan” (1999 June 2), and

WHEREAS we previously resolved “To Complete Detailed Architecture & Engineering for the Family Life Center” (2002 June 23), and

WHEREAS we previously resolved “To Change the Master Plan and to Proceed with the Family Life Center” (2006 Feb 26), and

WHEREAS our Family Life Center (FLC) Committee has presented updated FLC plans and estimated costs, and

WHEREAS God has given GSLC and its members the wherewithal to finance the FLC, and

WHEREAS our Family Life Center Committee has presented a “2006A Revision Master Plan” to the congregation which has carefully considered these issues, therefore be it

RESOLVED that Good Shepherd Lutheran Church adopts the “2006A Revision Master Plan” as presented by the FLC Committee (attached) as a guideline for the future growth of our ministry facilities, and also be it

RESOLVED that Good Shepherd Lutheran Church proceeds with Phase I, the building of the FLC, by financing it with a combination of

- a) Capital funding campaign(s)
- b) Property development of a “Seniors” Assisted Living Facility
- c) Long-Term Financing, if required, and
- d) Other gifts as God presents them,

and also be it

RESOLVED that the committees involved in realizing the FLC return to the voters at all major decision-making points, and also be it

RESOLVED that Good Shepherd Lutheran Church enters into this plan with faith in God to continue His Grace and to guide us with His Holy Spirit in our ministries for His Glory.
